A.R.I.L Statement of Purpose

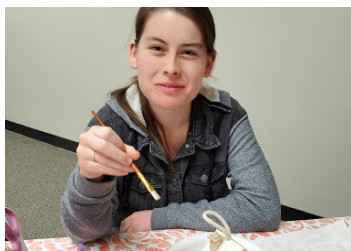
To offer a pathway for individuals with developmental disabilities to be able to develop their independent living skills with the best possible supports and quality of care.
