- Practice "Drop, Cover, and Hold On" at the designated time.
- Review your emergency plans and confirm that you have essential supplies such as water, food, medications, and other necessities for you and your loved ones.



*For adults accompanying children and not participating in carnival games or fun zone activities, wristbands are not required.


