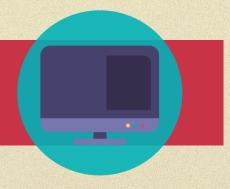

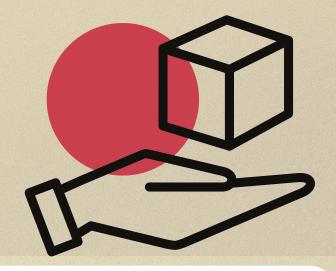
Services
