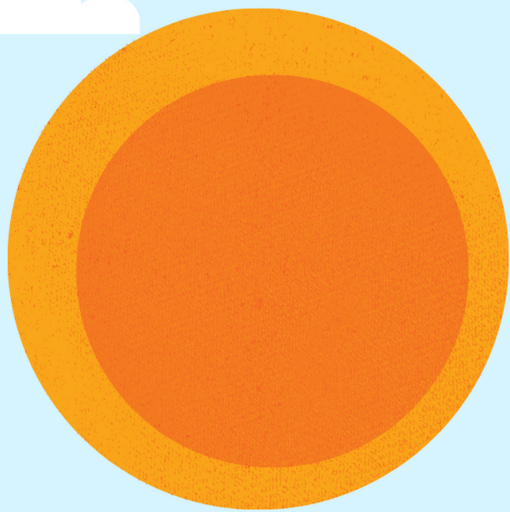

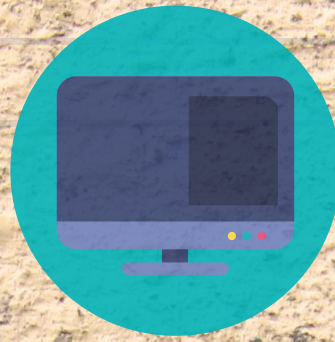

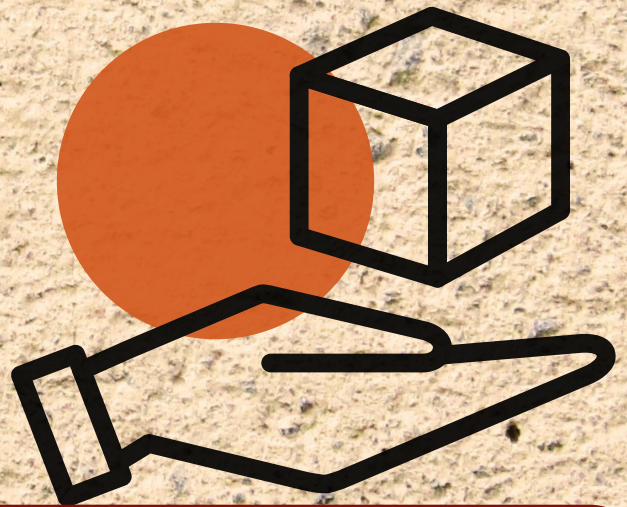

COVID-19 is still active, so be safe and continue to follow CDC guidelines

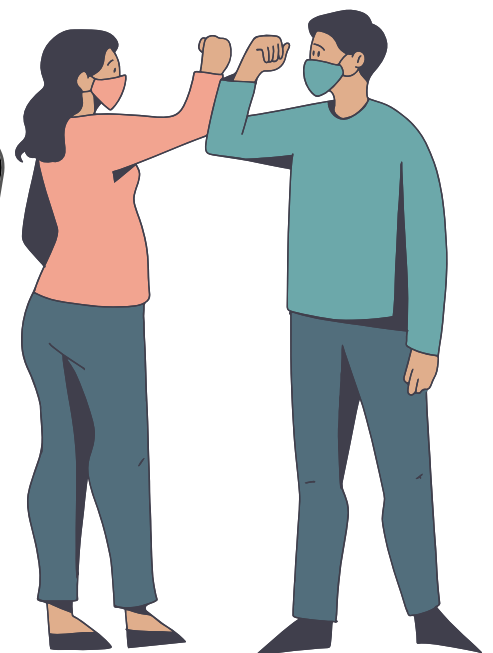
